President's Report

During 2007 AABIC was able to continue to assist its' members in the areas of **subsidies** for approved therapy programs and incontinent aids along with a number of specific equipment grants.

AABIC's **Incontinence Pad Buyers Group** continued to expand its patronage and we have also been able to provide additional subsidies to further assist families.

Membership has also undergone encouraging growth of almost 20%, and whilst demand for subsidies remains strong, there has been a marked shift in demand to equipment support.

Our primary **Fundraising event** held during the year was the ANZ Charity Golf Day. Thank you to the ANZ bank, its clients and our volunteers/members.

The use of the **Chessell Drive property** has been under review for some time. In partnership with Valued Independant People we are continuing to work towards the redevelopment of the property in 2008 as a shared community facility.

Thank you to all who contributed to, and supported our cause, our brain injured children.



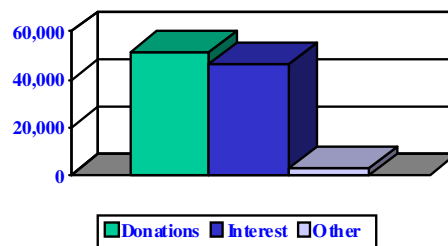
Treasurer's Report

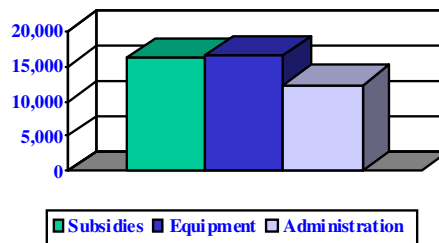
Over 63% of donations received during the year were spent on support services.
